**2019 NAVENBY BOWLS FESTIVAL
ORGANISED BY NAVENBY BOWLS CLUB

CONDITIONS

1. The tournament is open to bona fide amateurs and will be played under the rules of the english bowling federation, i.e. bowls must finish within 2 meters of the jack to count.
2. The entire management and control of the festival is vested in the committee whose decision shall be final and binding in all disputes.
3. Substitutes will not be allowed in the competition after initial participation.
4. Grey and whites and regulation shoes are to be worn in all matches. During the competition photographs will be taken for the taylor bowls and potters bowls holidays web sites so please maintain the dress code
5. Score cards will be issued prior to each game. They must be handed to the green steward immediately upon completion of the game, after being signed by both skips.
6. Players must make themselves aware of the time that they will be required for the next game and report not less than ten minutes prior to the scheduled time.
7. If opposing players agree, they may mutually appoint a scorer for singles matches, otherwise the organisers will do so. The green umpire will be readily available to arbitrate on all points of dispute not within the scope of the scorers on duty. The organisers will appoint scorers for all matches from the quarter finals onwards.
8. The smooth running of the tournament can only be achieved with the help and co-operation of competitors. Delaying tactics can create an upheaval of the entire time schedule and the organisers and umpire are empowered to take any action they consider necessary to ensure that the tournament is not delayed without reasonable cause. Any competitor not in attendance when the game is scheduled to start risks disqualification. Players must report ten minutes before the scheduled starting time and commence play promptly.
9. (a) in the unlikely event of a team withdrawal in a group and a replacement team cannot be found, the following will apply:
 - (b) the number of ends the remainder of the group play will be adjusted so that the total number of ends played will be the same as full groups. This will result in one fewer match, but more ends per match for that group.
 - (c) any point not provided for in the e.b.f. rules or the above conditions will be decided by the organisers.
10. All players who qualify for prize money and trophies must attend the presentation ceremony. Failure to do so will mean forfeiture of such, unless prior permission has been obtained from the organisers. This is to respect our much valued event sponsors.
11. In all competitions, first round matches will be played on a league basis. Group winners will be decided by the most points: win: 2 points, draw: 1 point. In the event of a tie, shot difference will decide. If scores are still level, highest shots scored will prevail. If highest shots are still level, an extra end will be played to determine the group winners.
12. Smoking and e cigarettes are not permitted whilst on the rink.
